



Daniel Clifton is a Partner and Head of Policy Research for Strategas Research Partners. In this capacity, Mr. Clifton evaluates government policy initiatives and its impact on the US and global economies, equity and bond markets for institutional investors. Daniel and his team have been recognized by *Institutional Investor* magazine in their annual survey for the past seven years. His research and political analysis on the interaction between legislation, policy and equity markets is often cited in the media. Dan is also a frequent guest on CNBC, Bloomberg, and Fox Business News.

Prior to joining Strategas, Mr. Clifton was Executive Director of the American Shareholders Association (ASA), a non-partisan, non-profit organization which analyzes public policy affecting shareholders. In this capacity, Daniel was one of the lead lobbyists on the successful efforts to lower capital gains and dividend tax rates to 15 percent, a repatriation tax holiday on foreign source revenue, and reform of the nation's pension system. Prior to joining ASA, Mr. Clifton was Federal Affairs Manager for Americans for Tax Reform and served as a senior staff member in two gubernatorial administrations working on economic and fiscal policy issues. Daniel has also worked in various capacities on elections at federal, state, and local levels. Mr. Clifton received both his BA in Urban Planning and his MS in Public Policy from Rutgers University where he was a Fellow at the Eagleton Institute of Politics and a Harold Martin Fellow for Public Policy.

Stanley Druckenmiller is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Duquesne Family Office LLC.

Mr. Druckenmiller founded Duquesne Capital Management in 1981, which he ran until he closed the firm at the end of 2010. From 1988 to 2000, he was a Managing Director at Soros Fund Management, where he served as Lead Portfolio Manager of the Quantum Fund and Chief Investment Officer of Soros (1989-2000), and had overall responsibility for funds with a peak asset value of \$22 billion. Early on in his career, Stan worked at Pittsburgh National Bank and The Dreyfus Corporation.

Mr. Druckenmiller is Chairman of the Board of the Harlem Children's Zone; a Board member for Memorial Sloan Kettering and the Environmental Defense Fund; a member of the Investment Committee of Bowdoin College and is Co-founder and Board member of Kasparov Chess Foundation.

He graduated Magna Cum Laude from Bowdoin College with degrees in Economics and English, and thereafter earned graduate degree credits in Economics from the University of Michigan.

Michael Drury is the chief economist for McVean Trading & Investments, LLC. He joined the firm in 1992, after serving for five years as senior economist with Allen Sinai at Shearson Lehman Brothers and its successor firms. He received his B.S. in economics from the Georgia Institute of Technology and did his graduate work at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Michael assesses macroeconomic developments around the world to help develop hedging strategies using futures markets in interest rates, currencies and industrial materials. He travels extensively in the United States and China, as well as to Japan, Europe and Latin America. Michael is the author of McVean Trading's "Weekly Economic Update." Colonel Jack Jacobs

Medal of Honor Recipient

Jack Jacobs was born in Brooklyn, New York. He holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees from Rutgers University and entered the U.S. Army in 1966 as a Second Lieutenant through the ROTC program. He served as a platoon leader in the 82nd Airborne Division, executive officer of an infantry battalion in the 7th Infantry Division, and commanded the 4th Battalion 10th Infantry in Panama. A member of the faculty of the US Military Academy, Jacobs taught international relations and comparative politics, and he was a member of the faculty of the National War College in Washington, DC.

He was in Vietnam twice, both times as an advisor to Vietnamese infantry battalions, earning three Bronze Stars, two Silver Stars and the Medal of Honor, the nation's highest combat decoration. Jacobs retired as a Colonel in 1987.

He was a founder and Chief Operating Officer of AutoFinance Group Inc, one of the firms to pioneer the securitization of debt instruments; the firm was subsequently sold to Key Bank. He was a Managing Director of Bankers Trust, where he ran foreign exchange options worldwide and was a partner in the institutional hedge fund business, raising more than \$2 Billion. Jacobs subsequently founded a similar business for Lehman Brothers and retired again in 1995 to pursue investments.

He is a principal of The Fitzroy Group, a firm that specializes in the development of residential real estate in London and invests both for its own account and in joint ventures with other institutions. He serves on a number of charitable boards of directors and is the Co-Chairman of the Congressional Medal of Honor Foundation and Director Emeritus of the World War II Museum.

Jacobs holds the McDermott Chair of Humanities and Public Affairs at the US Military Academy and is an on-air analyst for NBC News, where he was an Emmy nominee in 2010 and 2011 and a recipient of the 2011 Murrow Award for his work on the Nightly News segment "Iraq: The Long Way Out." Colonel Jacobs is also the author of the Colby Award-winning memoir, *If Not Now, When?*, published by Penguin in October 2008. His second work of non-fiction, *Basic*, was released by St. Martin's Press in 2012.




Chuck Royce

Philip Tetlock

Annenberg University Professor

Philip Tetlock is the Annenberg University Professor at the University of Pennsylvania, with appointments in Wharton, psychology and political science. He is co-leader of the Good Judgement Project, a multi-year forecasting study; the author of *Expert Political Judgement* and co-author of *Superforecasting*.

In Superforecasting, Tetlock offers a masterwork on prediction, drawing on decades of research and the results of massive, government-funded forecasting tournament. **The Good Judgment Project** involves tens of thousands of ordinary — including a Brooklyn filmmaker, a retired pipe installer, and a former ballroom dancer — who set out to forecast global events. Some of the volunteers have turned out astonishingly good. They've beaten other benchmarks, competitors, and prediction marks. They've even beaten the collective judgement of intelligence analysts with access to classified information. They are "superforecasters."
