Mr. Bohnsack is co-founder and partner of Strategas. He is the President and Chief Operating Officer of the Firm and heads the Firm's Institutional Securities and Financial Solutions business groups.

As an analyst, Mr. Bohnsack is head of Strategas' Quantitative Research team and directs the Firm's equity sector strategy and global asset allocation research efforts. More granularly he and his team focus on industry-level earnings and valuation forecasting and fundamental factor analysis to assist institutional investors in portfolio construction and thematic idea generation. He has been a regular guest on business news programs and has been widely quoted in the domestic and foreign press, particularly for his work on corporate profits and market valuation.

Prior to co-founding Strategas, Nicholas was an Investment Strategist and Associate Managing Director with International Strategy & Investment (ISI) Group. Nicholas began his career in the Investment Banking Group at FactSet and in Restricted Securities at Morgan Stanley.

Mr. Bohnsack received his MS in Mathematics from Fairfield University and received bachelor's degrees in Economics and Finance from Bryant University. He is a member of the Board of Advisors at Bryant University's College of Business. Nicholas and his wife, Brooke, live in Connecticut with their three sons.

Jon AlpertAward-winning journalist

Over the past thirty years, <u>Jon Alpert</u> has distinguished himself as an award-winning journalist. He has won three Primetime Emmys, eleven National News & Documentary Emmys and one National Sports Emmy. He has also won 3 Columbia-DuPont awards, a Peabody, and lots of other honors. He is unique among reporters because in addition to his awards for content he has won multiple Emmys in the craft categories—for his camerawork and editing. He is credited—or blamed—as one of the originators of the one-man-band verite style of reporting.

Alpert has consistently gained unprecedented access to world leaders and historic events during the past four decades—the first American TV reporter in VietNam after the war—interviews with Fidel Castro and Saddam Hussein—battlefield coverage from Angola to Afghanistan, Cambodia to Central America. Alpert has a history of bringing visibility to the invisible and his reports from around the world and all parts of the United States have been widely broadcasted on HBO and on NBC, ABC, CBS, PBS, ESPN, and NHK. Alpert is the Co-founder of the <u>Downtown Community Television Center (DCTV)</u>. Although there are no records for this, Jon likes to claim that DCTV is the United States' largest and most honored non-profit community media center. DCTV is located in a landmark firehouse in New York City's Chinatown.

He also teaches Television Documentary at Columbia University.

Mr. Trennert is the Managing Partner of Strategas Research Partners LLC and the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of the firm's broker-dealer subsidiary, Strategas Securities, LLC. In addition, as Chief Investment Strategist, Mr. Trennert is known as one of Wall Street's top thought leaders on the subject of markets and economic policy. His research pieces are read by leading institutional investors and corporate executives across the globe.

In 2006, Mr. Trennert co-founded Strategas, which originally began with just five employees. Today, the firm employs over fifty research analysts, institutional salesmen, and sales traders at its offices in New York and Washington D.C.. Prior to founding Strategas, Mr. Trennert was the Chief Investment Strategist and a Senior Managing Director at International Strategy & Investment (ISI) Group where he built and oversaw two of that Firm's most popular research efforts, its Company Surveys and Investment Strategy groups.

Widely quoted in the domestic and foreign press, Jason is a regular guest host on CNBC's "Squawk Box" and "Bloomberg Surveillance" with Tom Keene. His second book, My Side of the Street, was published by St. Martin's Press in May.

He was the Treasurer of La Scuola d'Italia where he built its investment committee. He is a member of the Board of Governors of The Columbus Citizens Foundation and a member of the investment committee of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund.

He has an MBA from The Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania and BS in International Economics from Georgetown University.

Mr. Rissmiller is a founding Partner of Strategas and has directed the Firm's macroeconomic research efforts since 2006. He oversees Strategas' thematic research as well as high-frequency econometric forecasting.

Prior to co-founding Strategas in 2006, Mr. Rissmiller was an Economist and Managing Director at International Strategy & Investment (ISI) Group.
